



## Estimated 7 Day Trip Budget

### Airfare:

Fares are roughly **\$2,000\*** per person for roundtrip airline ticket from the US to Kigali, Rwanda – Cost is approximate, depending upon routing/airlines chosen.

\* Air fares are subject to change until the time of purchase.

### Meals:

Total per person, **\$280-\$450**

### Ground Transportation:

**\$1000-1800** (up to 5 guests can share this expense)

### Hotels:

High End - **\$2000**

Mid-Level - **\$1200**

Standard - **\$750**

**Total Estimated Cost for the week (excluding additional activities): \$4,030 to \$6,250**

**\*Bridge2Rwanda has a minimum suggested donation of 30% of your total trip cost.**

**\*\*We suggest that you bring extra money for shopping/souvenirs, etc.**

### **Optional Recreational Activities:**

**Mountain Gorilla Trekking- \$525 per person.** Gorilla Permits are sold by the Rwandan Government and are available on a first come first serve basis. Once purchased, permits are non-refundable.

**Akagera National Park Safari- maximum \$70 per person.** This includes permits, guide fee, and boat tour.

**Nyungwe Rainforest Activities- \$30 – \$150 per person.** Includes canopy hike, colobus monkey and chimpanzee trekking, and several forest hikes.

**Iby'iwacu Cultural Village- \$35 per person.** Cultural walk through replica villages of Rwandan kingdoms of old. Learn ancient customs, experience the traditional Intore warrior dance, visit a medicine man and blacksmith... and much more.

**Helicopter Tour/Safari- \$600 per hour (3 passenger)**

Akagera Aviation has a 3 passenger and a 7 passenger helicopter that can give flights almost anywhere in the country (with some restrictions on weight and altitude).

**RDB Lake Kivu Jet Boat- \$1200 per day**

High speed jet boat can cover the entire western border of the country in 2 hours. Holds up to 17 passengers.
